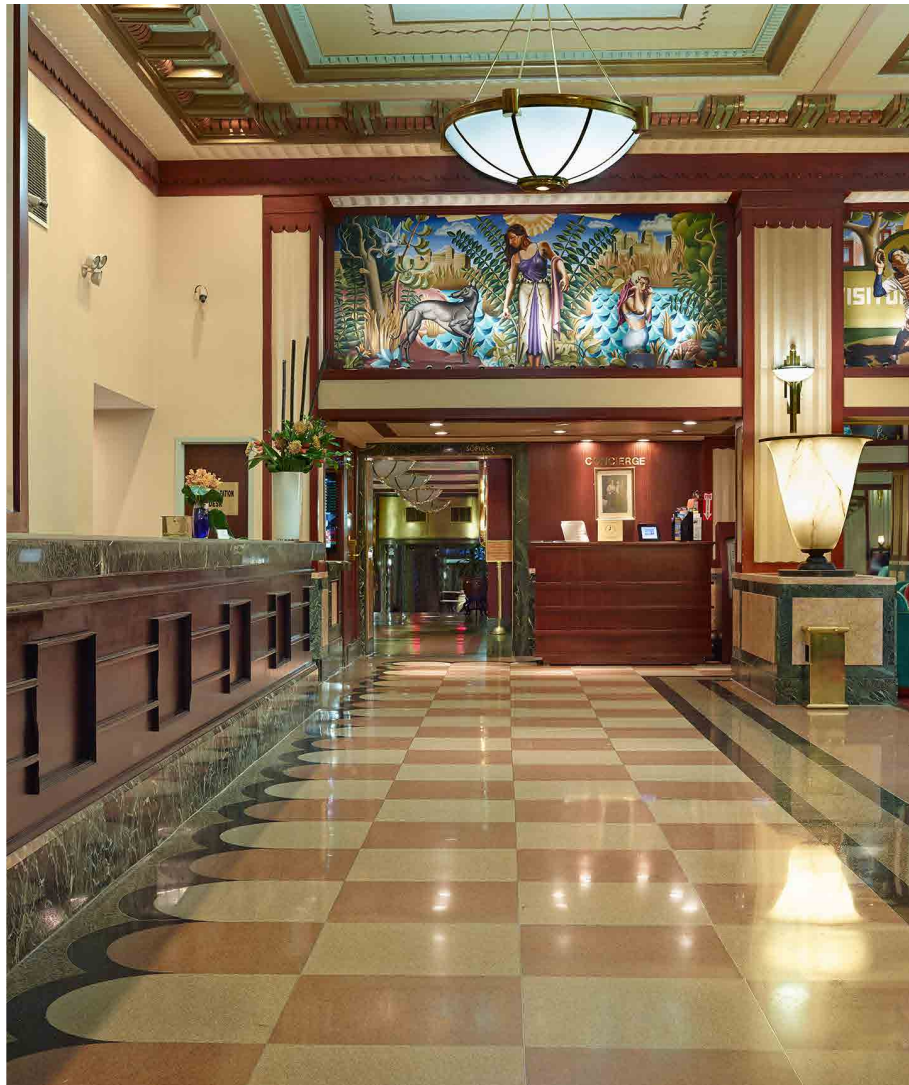

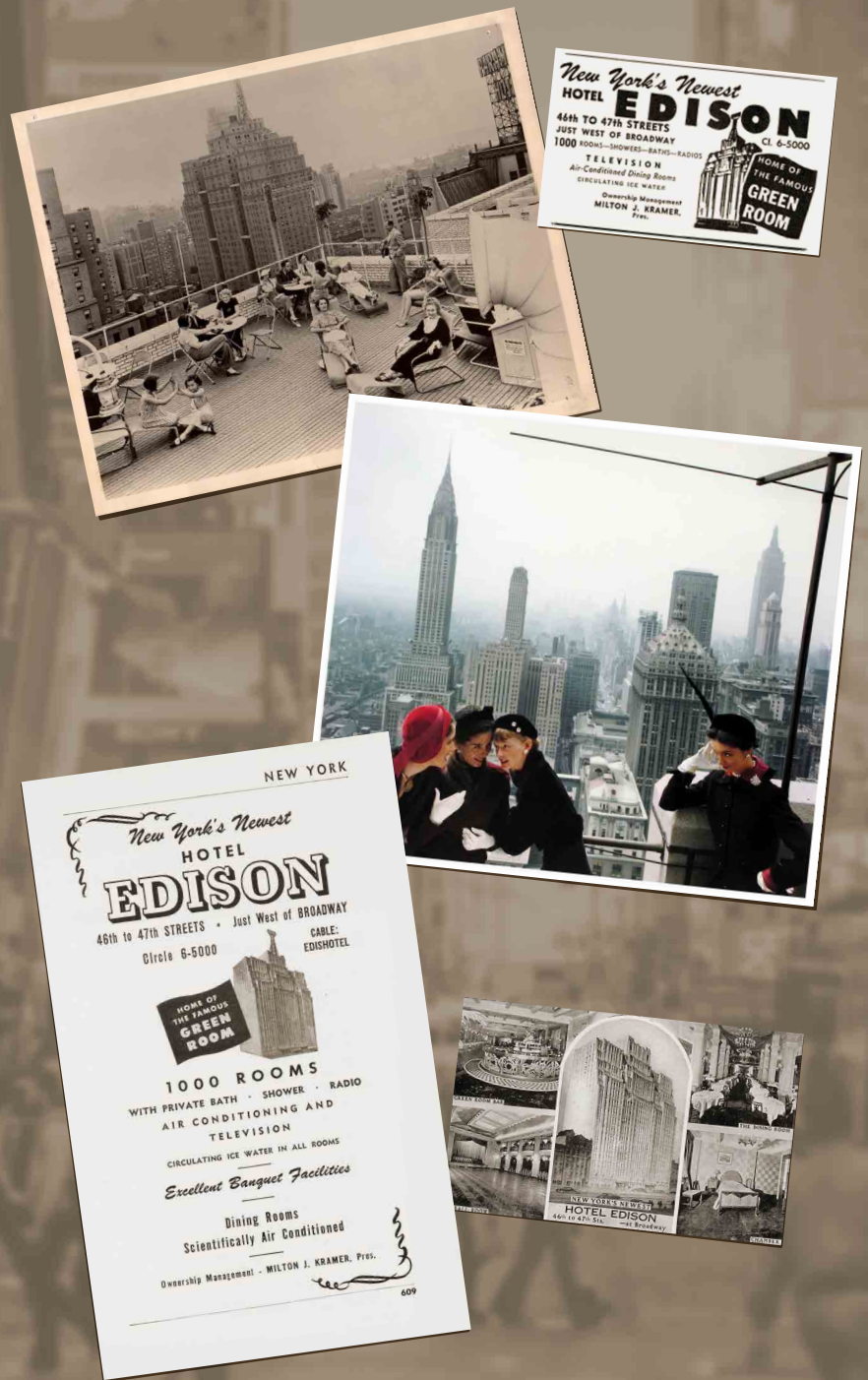




An Authentic New York Experience in Times Square

Krapp, who was known for designing many of NYC's Broadway theaters and landmarks, the hotel's striking design helped to usher in New York City's grand Art Deco era. Hotel Edison's namesake Thomas Alva Edison himself turned on the lights at the grand opening of the hotel and proudly holds the name of the famed American inventor to this day. Through the late 20th century, the hotel's recognizable spaces earned screen time in Hollywood hits such as *The Godfather* and *Birdman*.

In recent years, The Hotel Edison has cemented its status as a premier Times Square hotel with renovations and updates that pay homage to its historic past.

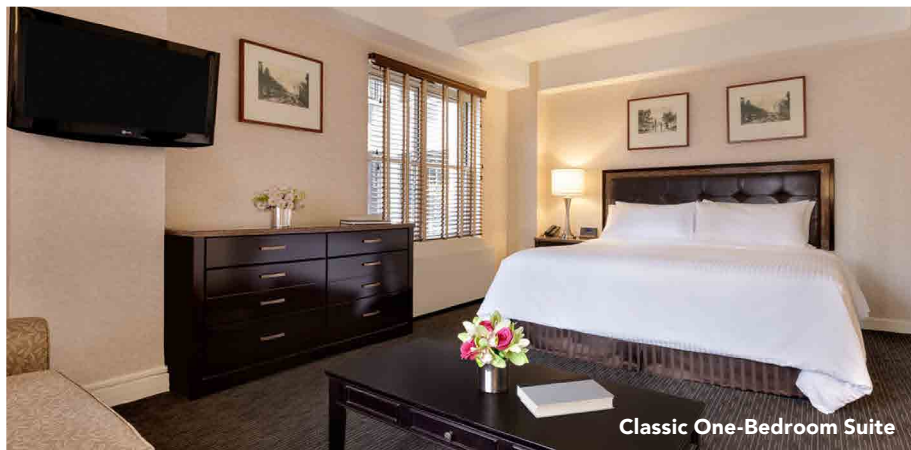
Accommodations to Suit Every Style
